To come on board, simply drop by the reception counters at the Singapore Art Museum, National Museum of Singapore and the Singapore Pinacothèque de Paris to obtain a Museum Shuttle sticker. Show your sticker to the driver before boarding.

Shuttle bus stops are at the front of each museum. Keep a look out for our signs marking the spot, and we'll see you there!

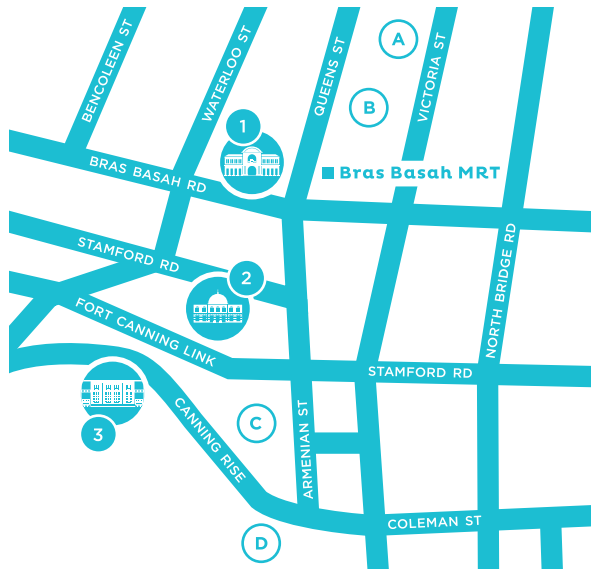
